Did You Know?

- French Immersion is a program of choice. That means school boards offer the program because parents ask for it. So it is important that parents continue to support the program, especially in this tough fiscal climate.
- Our CPF branch has four full-time staff along with a strong network of parent volunteers working on making French Immersion in Vancouver and BC better. We advocate with (and watchdog) school boards and the provincial government, support many extracurricular activities, and inform parents about local resources and ways to help their children succeed.
- Joining CPF is a great way to support French Immersion, because it gives CPF a stronger voice to advocate for the program. In turn, members benefit by access to members-only weekend and summer French camps, reduced charges at CPF events, such as parent information sessions, 40% off a select Children's Festival performance, and 10% off at several booksellers that offer French language books and resources.
- 80% of your membership fees return to our local CPF chapter (Vancouver North), and most of this money returns to our eight member schools.
